The Donor Engagement Specialist (DES) is a full-time non-exempt role in the Development Department, and will report to the Food Resource Manager.

Position Summary

Meet with retail grocery stores and distribution centers on a regular basis, keeping them informed about the food bank's programs, services, and donation guidelines. Attend store meetings and training sessions. Facilitate the Agency Empowerment Program. Track, monitor and report donation progress to staff, donors, and others as appropriate. Develop and manage donor recognition and retention program for retail donors.

The Donor Engagement Specialist will collaborate with the rest of the Second Harvest team to uphold our mission to "Engage, Feed and Educate."

Job Responsibilities

- Manage and sustain current Store Donation Program donor relationships through visits, presentations, phone calls, emails, thank you letters, and other correspondence
- Identify prospective donors; cultivate relationships and program support
- Create and follow donor visitation schedule
- Create and maintain donor contact lists and files
- Coordinate with food bank transportation department to monitor and adjust donation pick-up schedule as necessary
- Track, monitor and report donation progress to food bank staff, donors, and others as appropriate
- Respond timely to special needs and requirements of donors; troubleshoot problems preventing or hindering donor participation
- Logging donations received into Salesforce (weekly)
- Updating donor information as needed
- Produce reports for reconciliation with accounting software (monthly)
- Entering invoices into SAGE (weekly)
- Obtain manager approval on invoices prior to issuing check
- Cut A/P checks that are due and approved for payment, provide to CEO with supporting documentation for signature (weekly)
- Scan and mail checks (weekly and/or as needed)
- Other duties as assigned
